

<p><b>Preferred:</b></p> <p><i>(St Vincent's wants to have more of this type of patient)</i></p>	<p>ED to ED: Patient requiring immediate stabilization, procedure</p> <p>ED to Inpatient: We are open to all patients except for those listed below.</p>
<p><b>Possible:</b></p> <p><i>(St Vincent's can take care of this type of patient, but not necessarily looking to grow this service)</i></p>	<p>ED to ED:</p> <p>ED to Inpatient: open to all except those listed below</p>
<p><b>Never:</b></p> <p><i>(St Vincent's is not ideally equipped to take care of these patients)</i></p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Transplant</li> <li>• Trauma</li> <li>• Atraumatic SAH</li> <li>• Acute stroke needing revascularization</li> <li>• Acute Endocrine/rheumatology crisis—DKA is ok</li> <li>• Pediatrics</li> </ul>
