Tinsley serves as the general medicine inpatient ward service for the following specialties and groups of patients:

- General Internal Medicine (GIM) Faculty/ IM 4 Primary Care
- Infectious Diseases and the 1917 clinic
- Rheumatology, Endocrinology, and Dermatology
- All patients with HIV
- Outside referrals through the MIST operator
- Unattached patients through the ER with a <u>medical record number ending in 50-99</u>. (see 'unattached patients' below)

Unattached Patients

- Definition: Any patient who is not seen in one of the clinics listed under "The Patients" section above or a primary care clinic listed on the triage sheet above.
 - o Having a future appointment with a Prime Care physician or GIM attending attaches that patient to an inpatient service
 - o If a patient has not been seen by a provider in >3 years, they are considered unattached
 - All Orthopedic patients (fractures) are considered attached to the Hospitalist Service if they warrant "medical admission"
- Unattached patients with a <u>medical record number for the current admission encounter ending in 00-49 are to be admitted to the Hospitalist Service.</u>
- Unattached patients with a <u>medical record number for the current admission encounter ending in 50-99</u> are admitted to the Tinsley Harrison Service

Patients attached to non-teaching services and NOT attached to Tinsley include:

- Pulmonary Clinic patients (attached to Faculty Practice)
- CF and Advanced Lung Disease (attached to respective services)
- IM 1, 2, & 3, Family Practice, and Gerontology (see attached list for specific providers, attached to hospitalist)
- Ortho admissions (attached to hospitalist for co-management)

Pulmonary Patients

The Pulmonary wards teaching service is now closed. The Pulmonary Division still has the Cystic Fibrosis service and the Advanced Lung Disease Service. The DOM Faculty Practice service also is taking care of many of the patients on S6.

- For Pulmonary clinic patients:
 - CF admissions will go to the CF Service
 - Transplant admissions and IPF exacerbations will go to the Advanced Lung Disease Service
 - Other admissions will go to the DOM Faculty Practice Service
- o ED admissions:
 - If the patient needs intensive respiratory care on S6 or Pulmonary Step Down (high flow oxygen >20 liters, step down, airway clearance) patients will be admitted to DOM Faculty Practice Service
 - UAB Pulmonary Patients will go to DOM Faculty Practice Service
 - All others will be distributed based on attached status or MR# to Tinsley or Hospitalists
